


SR 520 construction update: November 2012


Floating bridge construction

Eastside construction




Crews used heavy equipment to make progress on SR 520 during the November 2012 closure. Photo taken near the 92nd Avenue Northeast interchange.

Pontoon construction



The second cycle of pontoons is well under way in Aberdeen, WA. Interior precast panels and rebar form the inside of the pontoon, which must be completed before the exterior walls can be poured into place.
