




# SR 520 decommission activities




# SR 520 decommissioning activities

Beginning as early as Monday, April 25, Kiewit/General/Manson (KGM) will begin decommissioning work to remove the old SR 520 floating bridge from Lake Washington. The pontoons have been sold and will be removed from the lake through the Hiram M. Chittenden Locks in Ballard. The majority of the remaining components will be dismantled onsite and hauled to concrete recycling facilities, where most of the materials will be processed for reuse as dry aggregate for other paving projects throughout the region. Below is a project timeline for decommissioning activities.

# What to expect during decommissioning

Decommissioning activities on the east approach of the existing bridge will begin as early as Monday, April 25, and continue through the end of 2016. After the east approach has been removed, KGM will begin shoreline restoration activities.

## How is KGM going to remove the bridge?

KGM will remove the bridge via water and land. Large sections of the bridge structure will be removed and transported offsite on barges, as permitted. Sections of the bridge located on land will be hauled offsite through the SR 520 corridor and approved haul routes.

## What kind of machinery can I expect to see and hear during decommissioning?

Neighbors can expect to see barges, cranes, excavation equipment, loaders, trucks and protective screening for neighbors near the shoreline

The noisiest work activities will take place during the first three months of decommissioning activities near the east approach. Decommissioning activities will continue through the end of 2016. Activities include removal of the bridge deck, nearby residents will hear a loud, consistent noise similar to an industrial fan; removal of components from the tops of pontoons, residents along the shoreline may hear cutting and dismantling of materials.

Dear neighbors,

WSDOT and its contractor Kiewit/General/Manson, A Joint Venture (KGM), are continuing to make progress on the new State Route 520 floating bridge. Crews are preparing to switch traffic onto the new bridge and as part of that work, will begin using new haul routes for trucks in January 2016. Please see below for additional information.

Since spring 2012, crews have utilized a temporary construction off-ramp from westbound SR 520 to access the construction site in Medina. Beginning January 2016, this temporary construction off-ramp will be intermittently closed to complete final concrete pours, roadway work, landscaping and other activities. The ramp will be permanently closed in March 2016. During intermittent closures and permanent closure of this off-ramp construction trucks will be required to use new haul routes through the cities of Medina, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Yarrow Point and Hunts Point.

New truck haul route details:

- New routes will begin January 2016 and last until December 2016.
- Truck hauling activities along these routes will typically occur:
  - 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday
  - 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday
- See attached maps for details of new truck hauling routes.

Residents can expect to see and hear the following:

- Weekly street sweeping along these haul routes.
- Truck hauling restrictions during school bus pick-up and drop-off times.

Beginning as early as April 2016, crews will close a temporary construction on-ramp from Evergreen Point Road to eastbound SR 520. This closure will require new truck hauling routes for vehicles leaving the construction site. See Phase 2 map for additional information.



## Phase 1 Expected duration: January 2016 – December 2016



### ← Trucks shorter than 40 ft.

From SR 520 WB, exit at 92nd Ave NE heading south, right on Points Drive NE, left on 84th Ave NE, right on 24th St, right on Evergreen Point Road

From SR 520 EB, exit at 84th Ave NE heading south, right on 24th St, right on Evergreen Point Road


### ← Trucks longer than 40 ft.

From Interstate 405, exit at NE 8th St heading west, slight right on NE 1st St, slight left on NE 12th St, right on 84th Ave NE, left on 24th St, right on Evergreen Point Road



# SR 520 Floating Bridge and Landings updated outbound haul routes

## Phase 2 Expected duration: April 2016 - December 2016



### Trucks from jobsite going westbound

Head south on Evergreen Point Road, left on NE 24th St, left on 84th Ave NE, drive through 84th Ave NE roundabout, then travel onto SR 520 WB



### Trucks from jobsite going eastbound

Head south on Evergreen Point Road, left on NE 24th St, left on 84th Ave NE, right on NE 28th St/Points Drive NE, left on 92nd Ave NE, then travel onto SR 520 EB
