### Target Audience

Engineers, planners, field personnel, foreman, safety inspectors, and other individuals involved with work zone temporary traffic control.

### Course Description

This training will emphasize key work zone topics including Utility Work Zones (11/1 and 11/3), Urban Work Zones (11/2), and Short-Term, Short Duration & Mobile Work Zones including tools such as, a Temporary Traffic Control Plan Selection Software and Work Zone Safety Compendium to assist those involved in highway work zone planning, design, implementation, and operation.

### Outcomes

This training will help participants identify key characteristics of different work zones and how to design, implement, and manage traffic control treatments within each type of work zone.

The instructors will provide participants with tools and resources needed to design effective temporary traffic control plans and assist with application of those tools for problem solving during the class.
