



Land use – Property acquisitions

In order to construct the project, there will be approximately 10 acres of property acquisitions:

- Full acquisitions:** 10 parcels
- Partial acquisitions and permanent easements:** 23 parcels

Land use in the project area is not expected to change.



Economics

The project will create more than 2,400 project-related jobs at the height of construction in 2012.

- Direct:** Jobs working directly on the project, such as construction workers.
- Indirect:** Jobs for producers of materials, equipment, and services used on the project, such as steel producers.
- Induced:** Jobs created when direct and indirect workers spend their increased incomes on consumer goods and services in the local and regional economy.

Job estimates were developed using methodology from the Governor's Office of Financial Management, which maintains a nationally recognized model that can be used to estimate the employment impact of highway construction projects.
