Local agency public works directors, managers, planners, engineers, and technicians.

Course Description

This course is designed to help local agencies meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) for transition plans within the public right of way. This course will present:

- survey results from local agencies in Washington State regarding their status on implementing transition plans.
- the components of a transition plan such as a self-evaluation.
- information (case studies) from local agencies that are completing transition plans.
- information on incorporating a transition plan into the comprehensive planning process.
- options for funding sources for ADA work.
