Pedestrian detours during sidewalk construction

Phase one: March 2 – 16

- Crews will construct wider and ADA compliant sidewalks
- Sidewalk closures along Montlake Boulevard will close in three phases through April
- Signage will direct pedestrians around work zones
- Please take extra time and precaution during your commute



Local street and highway closures

Directional highway closure

- Westbound SR 520 from 92nd Avenue Northeast to Montlake Boulevard
 - 11 p.m. March 13 to 5 a.m. March 16

Single-lane closures for geotechnical investigations

- Montlake Boulevard, in each direction
 - March 7 and 8
 - 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Southbound left-turn lane from Montlake Boulevard to East Lake Washington Boulevard
 - March 14 and 15
 - 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.


