ORDINANCE NO. 232

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 12.09 OF THE WOODINVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT NEW STREET AND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville is one of the fastest-growing cities in western Washington, a fact which underscores the critical nature of the challenge facing the City's public facilities, including streets and intersections; and

WHEREAS, travel through Woodinville is heavily dependent on the automobile. However, much of the City's current transportation system can be characterized as a limited arterial system and limit transit system; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Citizen Advisory Panel was established in January 1997, and developed new standards to guide the development of the City's infrastructure system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville Council wishes to update its standards to ensure that the City's infrastructure and its management meet the needs of the City's future populace and economy; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville Council desires to amend Chapter 12.09 of the Woodinville Municipal Code to adopt said standards; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Standards Adopted Section 12.09.010 of the Woodinville Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 12.09.010 Standards Adopted.

The City of Woodinville hereby adopts by reference Exhibit A, entitled "City of Woodinville Public Infrastructure Standards and Specifications, 1998 Edition". A copy of Exhibit A is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full.


Section 2. Repealer. Section 12.09.020 of the Woodinville Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Savings The amendments to Chapter 12.09 of the Woodinville Municipal Code by this ordinance shall not affect the validity and enforcement of said chapter prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


