## **Good To Go!**

Transponder shield instructions for customers carpooling in the SR 167 HOT Lanes



IMPORTANT  
Read all of these instructions before installing your transponder or the shield device

## 1 Properly install your transponder

Please be careful when peeling the clear backing away from the transponder (the side WITHOUT the barcode) to avoid damage to the transponder. When the transponder is properly installed, the barcode should be facing the interior of the vehicle.




## 2 Properly install your transponder shield

Before you can use the shield, you will need to position it so that it is centered over the transponder on the inside of your windshield.

First, peel the clear backing away from the Velcro strips. Leave both pieces of Velcro attached to the shield.



Next, place the shield over your transponder so the Velcro strips touch both the left and right sides of the transponder. When the shield is on the windshield, and correctly centered over the transponder, it will completely cover the transponder, as shown.



## 3 Remove the shield

Slowly remove the transponder shield from your windshield, making sure one set of Velcro strips remain attached to the windshield, and one set stays on your transponder shield.



After you remove the transponder shield from your windshield, you should see a strip of Velcro on both the left and right sides of the transponder.

## 4 Use your shield to CARPOOL in the SR 167 HOT Lane

When you CARPOOL in the SR 167 HOT Lanes, no toll is necessary, so shield your *Good To Go!* transponder. Your transponder is inactive when the shield is in place, and tolls will not post to your account.



When you travel in the SR 167 HOT Lanes as a single occupant driver, you must pay the toll electronically using *Good To Go!*. **Do not** use your shield if you are driving alone.

### REMEMBER:

The transponder shield can only be used to CARPOOL on the SR 167 HOT Lanes. If you travel over the Tacoma Narrows Bridge, regardless of the number of occupants in your vehicle, you must remove the shield to pay the toll electronically. Unpaid tolls on the bridge can result in a \$49.00 toll infraction.
