



# Full SR 520 Closure

## 11 p.m. Oct. 7 - 5 a.m. Oct. 10



From **11 p.m. Friday, Oct. 7**, to **5 a.m. Monday, Oct. 10**, all lanes and ramps of SR 520 are scheduled to close.

- SR 520 will close from 92nd Avenue Northeast to Montlake Boulevard.
- The bicycle and pedestrian path on the new floating bridge will be closed to all users.

### What to expect during the weekend closure


- **Restriping** of SR 520 between Evergreen Point Road and the new floating bridge.
- Maintenance of the **temporary tolling system**.
- Installation of **permanent tolling equipment**.
- Lid maintenance at Evergreen Point, 84th Avenue Northeast and 92nd Avenue Northeast.


## What to expect Monday morning, Oct. 10

Crews will restripe the westbound merge lane on the floating bridge over the weekend. Doing this allows for a smoother transition from three lanes to two lanes on the existing SR 520 west approach bridge.

### Before restriping




### After restriping





# Girder delivery continues for next 4 to 6 months



- **Nighttime truck deliveries:** Intermittent deliveries between **9 p.m. and 5 a.m.** up to five nights per week, Monday through Friday.
- **Intermittent flagging:** Flaggers will briefly hold traffic traveling in both directions on East Lake Washington Boulevard and on the westbound SR 520 off-ramp to East Lake Washington Boulevard. There will also be a rolling slowdown on the eastbound SR 520 on-ramp from Montlake Boulevard.
- **Parking restrictions:** Parking will be restricted at night on **East Lake Washington Boulevard** between Montlake Boulevard and 24th Avenue East.
- **Construction lights:** Bright lights may be seen as crews install girders overnight. For safety, crews may use flood lights in addition to lights from construction equipment to illuminate the work area.
- **Noise:** At night, you may hear crews bringing girders in by truck and using cranes to install them. Crews will also use hammers to attach brackets to the girders on the temporary work bridge.


*All casings, shafts and columns for the permanent WABN structure are complete.*

*More than 50 percent of all girder installation for the permanent WABN structure is complete.*



# Construction progress



*Seventy percent of the isolation bearings are installed for the permanent WABN structure.*






*Crews continue to place concrete for the deck. Thirteen sections of roadway deck are now complete.*
