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## SR 520 construction update: January 2014

### Eastside construction



In January, crews laid down fresh asphalt to realign lanes in a temporary configuration. The realignment was needed to enable additional upgrades to the Eastside corridor.



Crews make progress on the Evergreen Point Road lid in Medina, where a new stairway (in background) will allow bus riders to descend from the lid to an in-median transit stop at highway level.

## Floating bridge construction - Lake Washington



The south section of the new east approach structure begins to take shape along the shoreline in Medina. When complete, it will transition eastbound traffic from the new floating bridge on Lake Washington to the roadway on the Eastside.



Crews continue to make progress on the cross beam atop Pontoon W, which is currently anchored in its permanent location on Lake Washington near the shoreline in Medina. It will be the eastern-most pontoon for the new floating bridge.

## Pontoon construction - Tacoma



Crews use massive formwork to support construction of new supplemental stability pontoons in Tacoma. The fifth cycle of pontoons built in Tacoma is currently underway.



These massive concrete pontoons continue to take shape in the casting basin located in Tacoma.
